The purpose of this course is to provide students with the necessary skills to increase their self-awareness and as well confidence when speaking and presenting to internal or external audiences.


The course also focuses on understanding your audiences and how to prepare the right content for them while keeping them engaged throughout.

It is also helpful to those who wish to develop skills that could help them in careers such as those represented in the chart below.






The course curriculum is centered on three key aspects of public speaking:

Four (4) different ways of delivering speech such as impromptu, Manuscript, Memory, and Extemporaneous speech delivery are explicitly taught in the video.




Students will understand various ways presentation aids can help deliver a better public speaker and also gain the required knowledge in the use of advanced presentation aids that you can make good use of.
